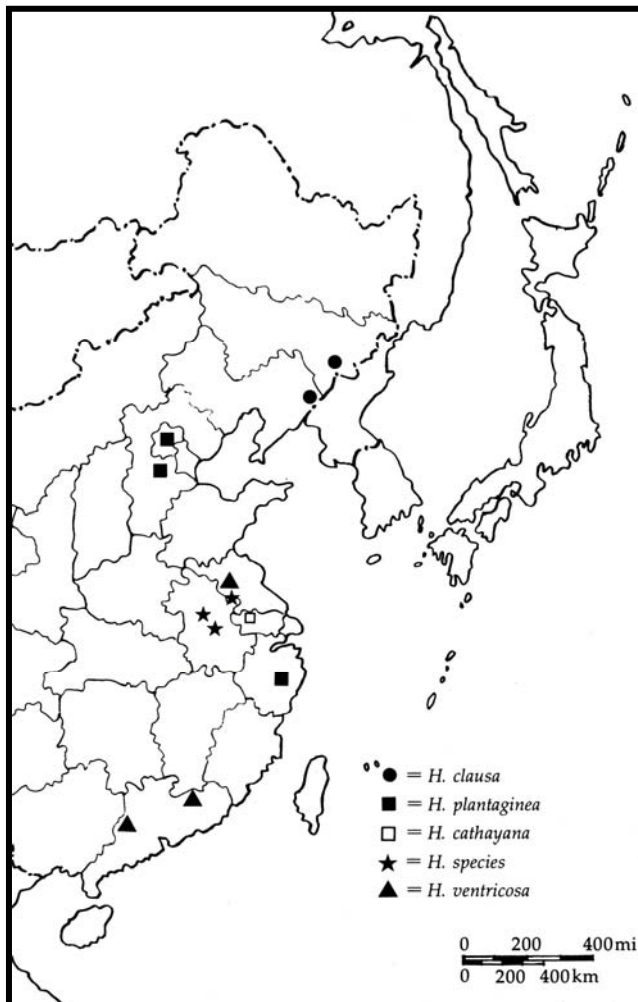

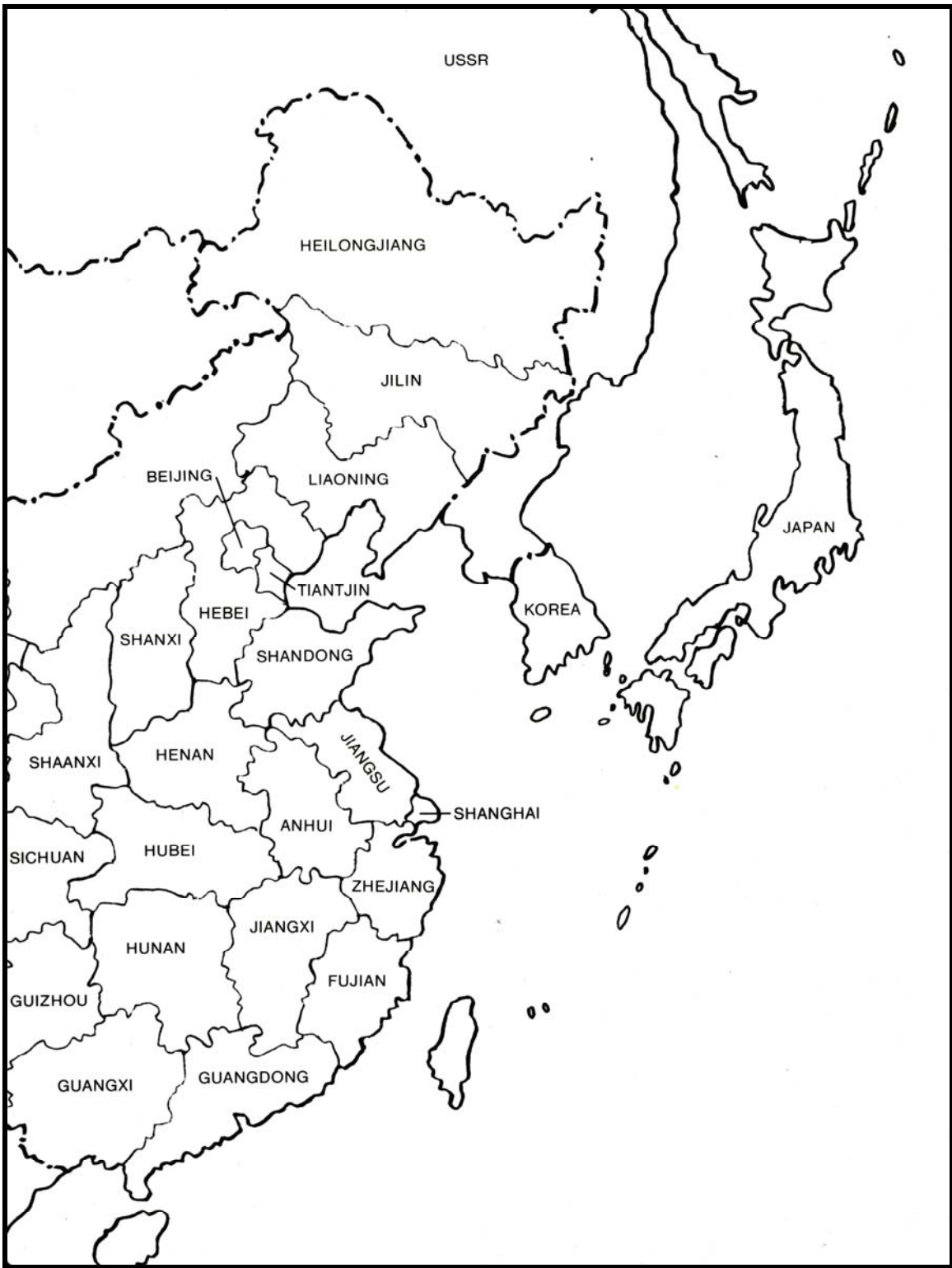
A Provincial Map of China is on Page 2

A Prefectural Map of Japan is on Page 9

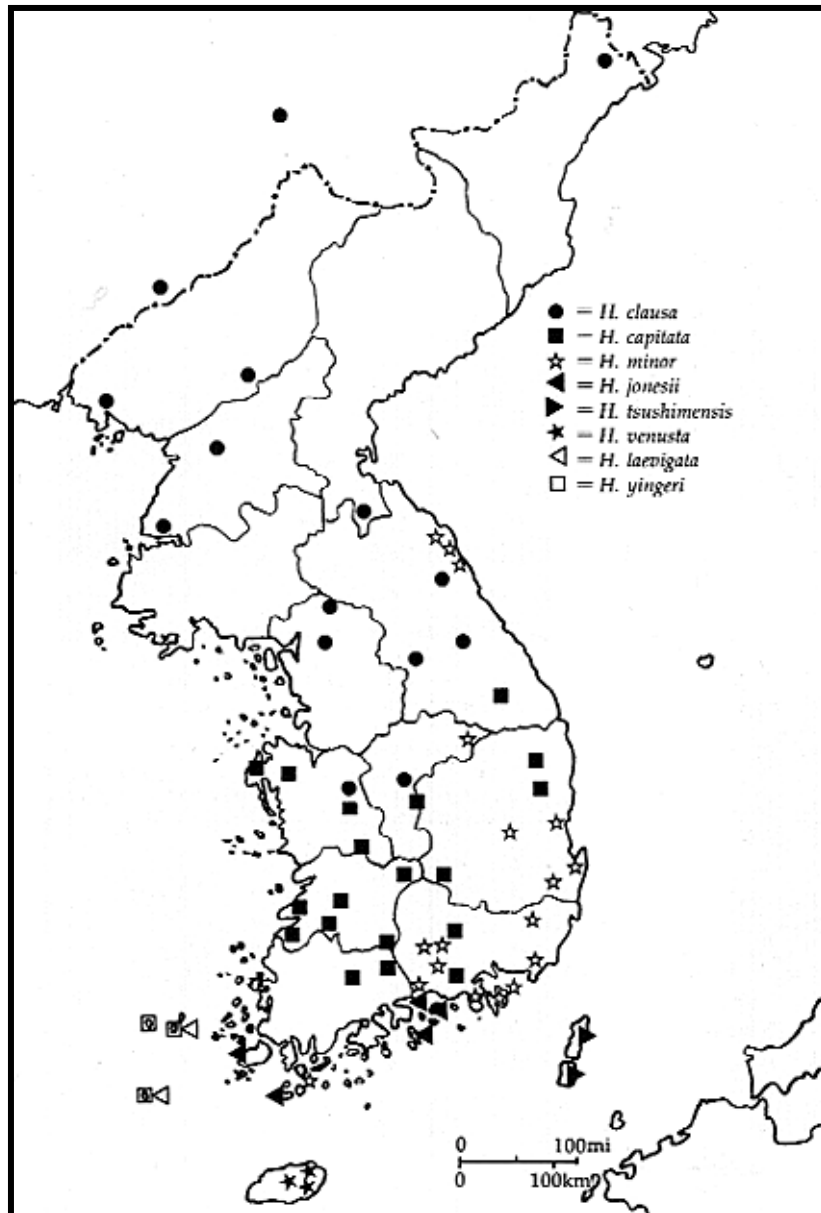


Chinese Species: According to *Flora of China* (FOC), 4 species occur in China. Only one species was not been mentioned in my book, *The Genus Hosta – Giboshi Zoku*, (1991), namely *H. albofarinosa* D. Q. Wang 1989 (白粉玉簪 bai fen yu zan). This species occurs in Anhui Province and was indicated on my 1991 Map to the left by stars. Details of its discovery did not reach me in time to be included in my book. *H. ensata* Maekawa 1937 is also in FOC as an endemic in China, called 东北玉簪 dong bei yu zan. This taxon was included in my book as *Hosta clausa* Nakai var. *ensata* (F.Maekawa) W.G. Schmid 1991 and is indicated on my 1991 map in Liaoning and Jilin Provinces by a round dot. FOC calls it an endemic in Liaoning Province

Provincial Map of China

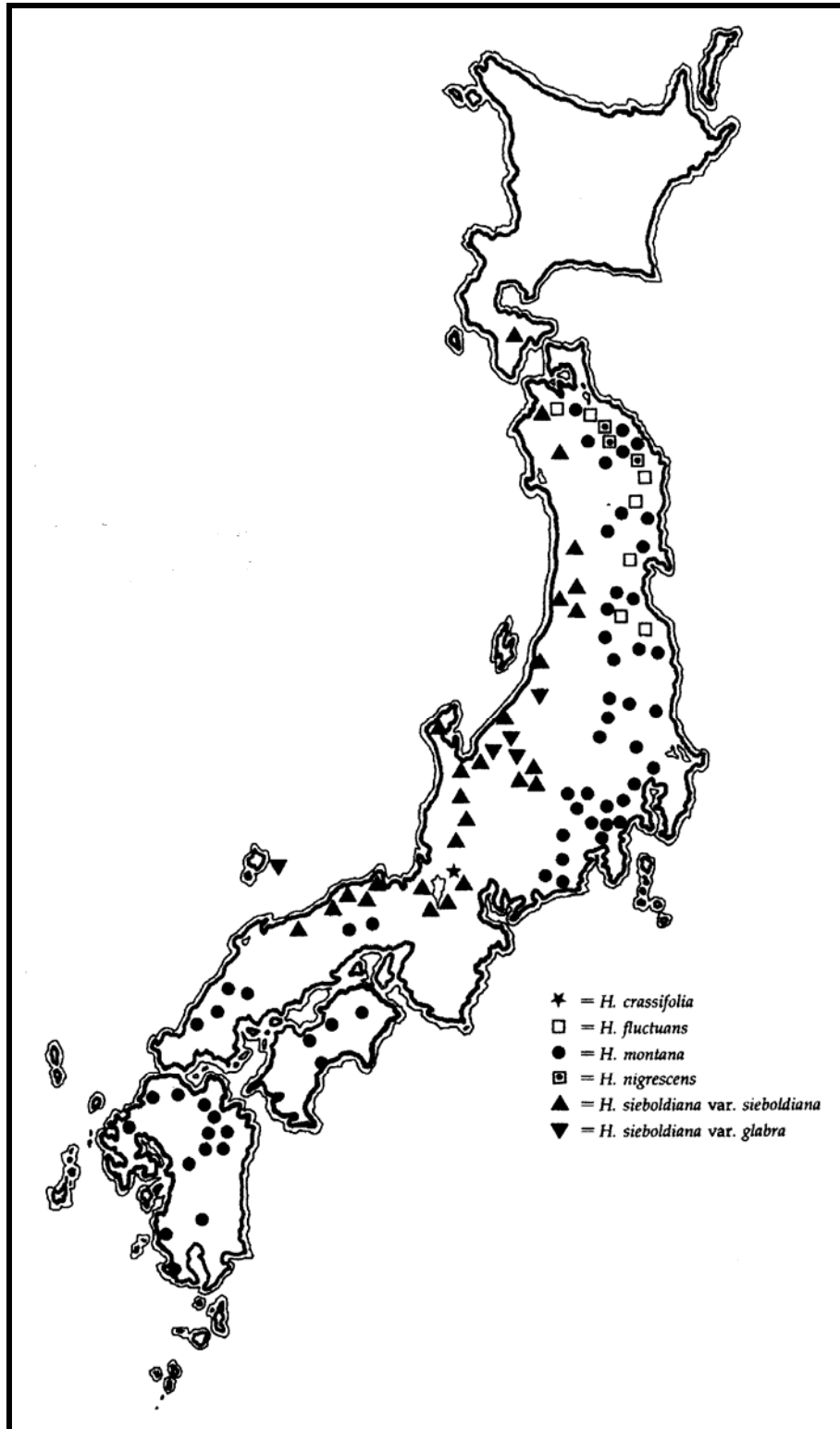


Distribution Map for Korea by W.G.Schmid 1991

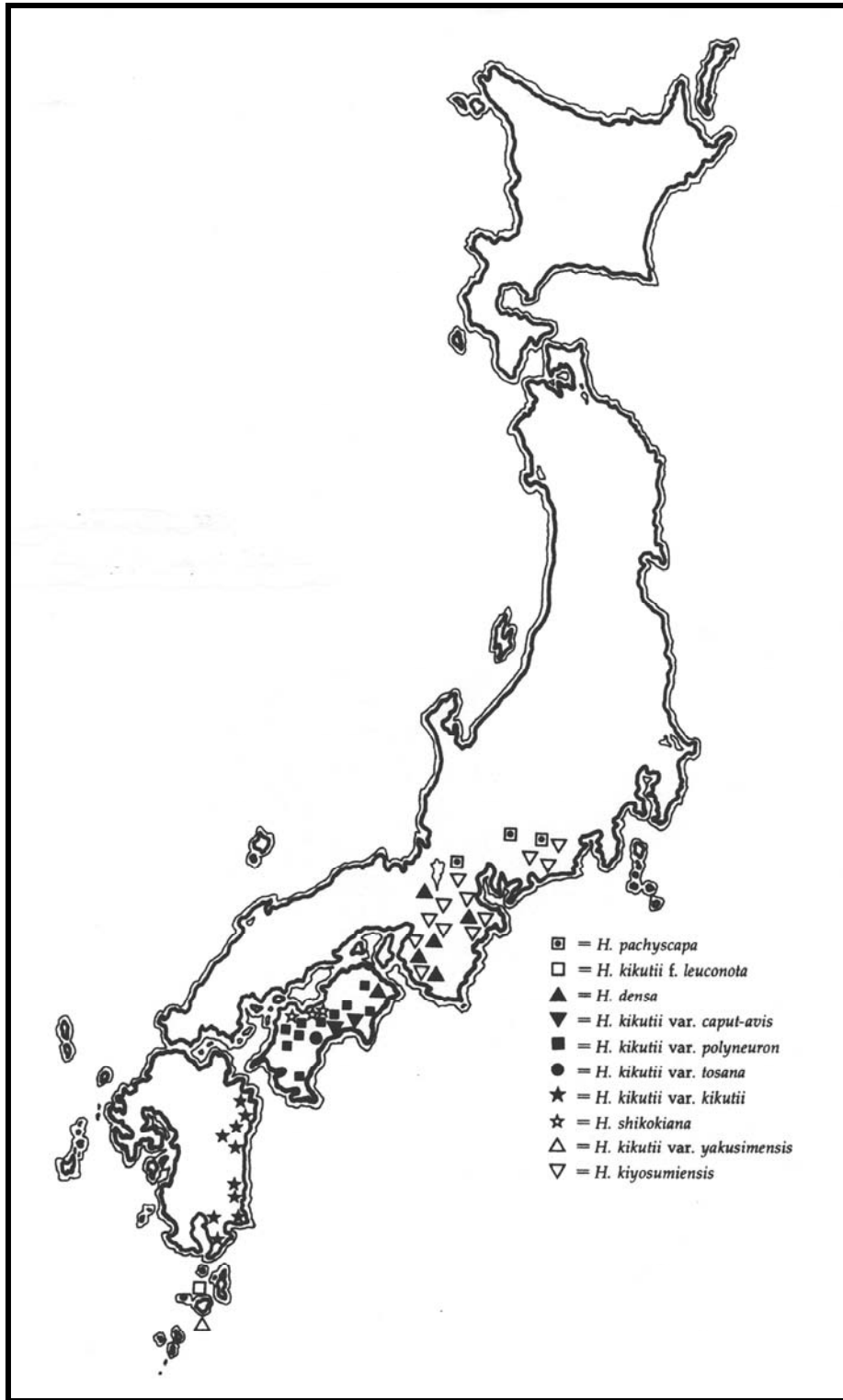

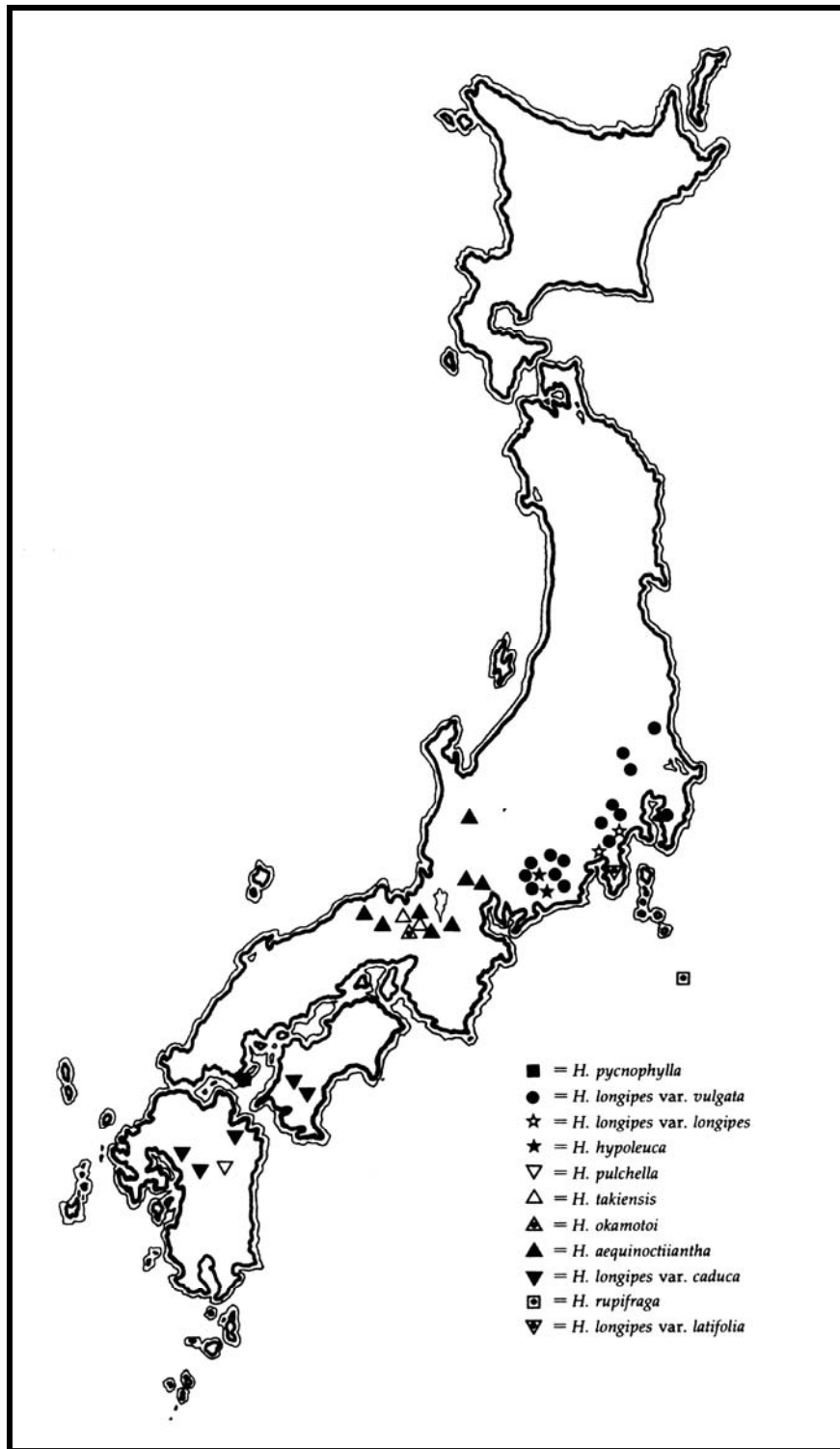
Distribution Map Japan: Section *Helipteroides*

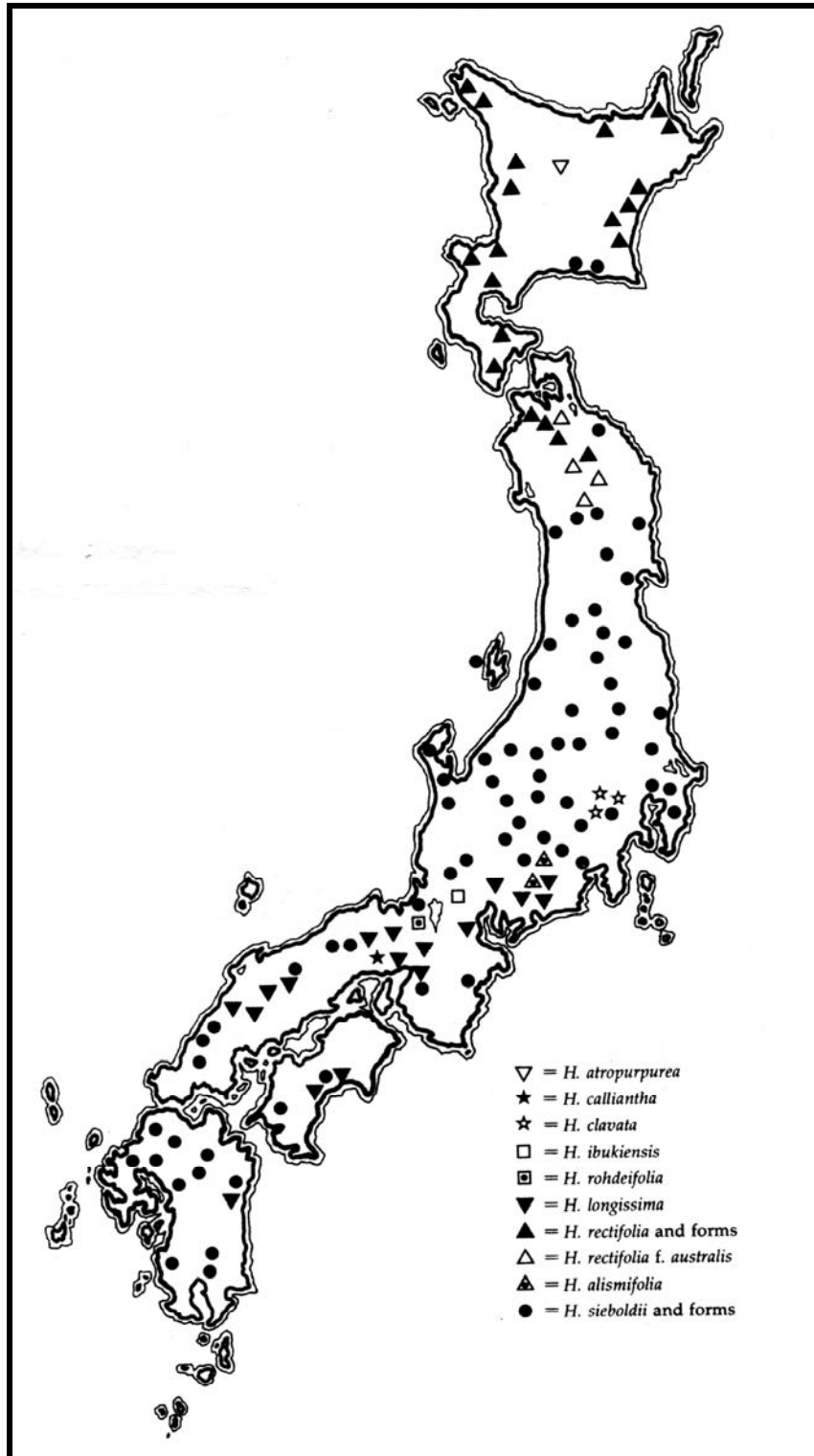
Distribution Map Japan: Section *Rynchophorae*

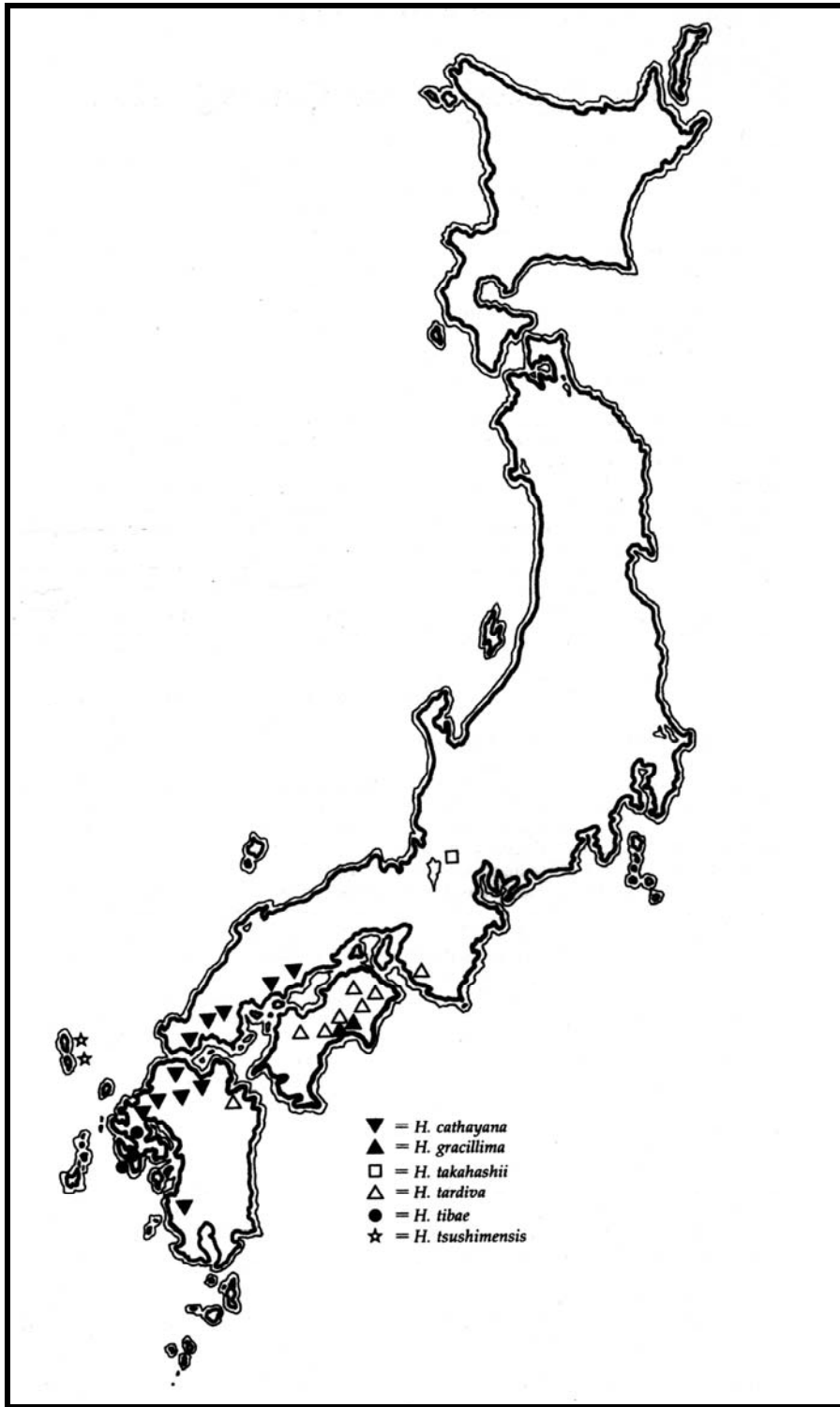
Distribution Map Japan: Section *Picnolepis*
